As part of the program requirements, we are calling upon students who are passionate about food and culture to submit a recipe using only Kimberley local produce and/or bush foods grown, harvested, produced or fished in the Kimberley area.

The Kimberley Kids in the Kitchen offers a unique opportunity for students to explore their creativity while showcasing the rich flavours and ingredients unique to the region. By creating recipes using locally sourced ingredients, students will not only learn about the diverse culinary heritage of the Kimberley but also contribute to the promotion of sustainable food practices and cultural preservation.

To express interest in participating in the Kimberley Kids in the Kitchen, students are asked to submit their original recipe, along with a brief description highlighting the significance of their chosen ingredients and any cultural inspiration behind their dish. Recipes should showcase the use of local produce and/or bush foods from the Kimberley region. Once recipes are submitted, they will be reviewed by Chef Don Hancey and 10 best recipes will be selected for a cook off as part of the FEASTival event, being judged and mentored by a selection of profile judges from the Kimberley. There will be lots of prizes up for grabs!

**Age range: 10 to 16 years old**

**Recipe submission deadline: 23 August 2024**

**Participation requirements: Students must submit an original recipe using only local produce and/or bush foods from the Kimberley region.**
